## Cape Fear Pickleball Club Guidelines for use of Simon pickleball machine 5/22/2017

- 1. Simon is the name of the pickleball machine that the Cape Fear Pickleball Club has purchased for use by its members. Simon will shoot pickleballs out of the machine at a velocity, angle, and interval that can be set by the user, so that the user may practice dinks, groundstrokes, volleys, and overheads. Simon is 30 inches tall by 13 inches wide by 13 inches deep and weighs 32 pounds. We have a dolly with which to maneuver Simon. There is also a metal hopper that fits on top of Simon, and a large bucket of balls.
- 2. The Simon pickleball machine and accompanying equipment will be stored at the home of EJ Hanley, 2137 E. Lake Shore Dr. When not in use, they must be kept in a locked location. EJ will be responsible for adhering to these guidelines.
- 3. Any CFPC member may rent Simon. To do so, the member must contact EJ to arrange the date, time, and method of pick-up of the machine and accompanying equipment from EJ's house and return of the machine and other equipment to EJ's house. EJ can be contacted by phone (910-622-8513) or via email (ellahanley1@twc.com).
- 4. EJ will ensure that Simon is fully charged before each rental.
- 5. EJ will ensure that each person who uses Simon is knowledgeable about how the machine works. This includes the instruction that only the provided pickleballs may be used with the machine.
- 6. Simon may only be used at the Greenfield Lake pickleball courts.
- 7. The cost for each rental session is \$5. EJ will collect this money and periodically deliver it to the CFPC President or Treasurer for deposit into the CFPC account.
- 8. Each rental session shall be good for a minimum of two hours, and a maximum of five hours. Details to be worked out between the renting member and EJ.
- 9. EJ will maintain a log of usage of the machine. The log shall include the date and time at which the member picked up the machine from EJ, and the date and time at which it was returned. The renting member must sign for the machine upon pickup, and EJ must sign for the machine upon its return. The log shall also include a prominent note that the renting member is responsible for reasonable care of the machine.
- 10. The renting member must agree to return the machine and all accompanying equipment in the same condition as they were in when he picked them up, except for reasonable wear. If any equipment is not returned, or is returned in substantially worse condition, the renting member will be responsible for paying to repair or replace that equipment. The maximum cost for damage to or loss of Simon shall be \$600. The maximum cost for other equipment (dolly, storage box, balls) shall be the full cost of replacing that equipment.
