

Minutes of Cape Fear Pickleball Club Board
Meeting Date Feb 10, 2016

The meeting was held at The Harp Irish Pub and convened at 7:00 p.m. President Kevin Chandler presiding. OLD BUSINESS

Kevin Chandler reported that as approved, he purchased a one-year liability insurance policy for the club. The cost was \$685.

The Jesse Simon request for club help has been cancelled. The club offered to provide free consultation for the school. However, the school decided to pay a contractor for the service.

NEW BUSINESS

The Board approved Brent Young as the new Director of Competition.

The Board welcomed member Jeanne Bua's request for the club to provide volunteers for the Healthy Kids Day at Empie Park on Saturday, April 30th from 9:30 am to 1:00 pm. Volunteers will demonstrate the game and interact with the children. Jeanne will organize club participation.

The club will seek standby volunteers to help line 3 courts at the Wilmington basketball center on March 17. This will only be necessary if the Dink For Pink competition is forced inside due to inclement weather.

OFFICER REPORTS:

Treasurer Jane Klippel reported that the current checking account balance for the club is \$2013.00. As of the meeting date there are no outstanding bills or receivables.

Membership Director Elaine Chandler reported that the club now has 136 members and is growing. Elaine is pursuing options for getting shirts printed with the Club logo, to be sold to Club members. She will send an email to the membership to gauge interest.

Social Events co-directors Carolyn Ryan and Feri Nejad reported on their plans for a total of four social events during the year. The first upcoming event will be a cookout in May

Communications Director Harry Marriner reported that the website has been updated to include photos for member contacts.

Competition Director Brent Young reported that thus far there is minimal interest in competition within the club. He will pursue various options for future competition.

Training Director Mike McGrath reported that beginner training attendance at the WAC has been erratic. Some classes are sold out immediately while others are poorly attended. These classes are scheduled the first Tuesday and Thursday every month. Mike is exploring the possibility of more intermediate training sessions.
