In response to member feedback, an additional drill and skills training has been added for all levels of players on Sunday morning (maximum of 20 players). The current pickleball machine has been refurbished but the club will purchase an additional machine to be used for both training and outreach events.

Two social events were held this year (May & September). Between 80-100 people attended. There was no cost to members who attended these events.
